Spring Term Maths Event

Tuesday 7th March 2017 6pm - 7.30pm, School Hall

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the success of last year's Science event, we are delighted to invite the Key Stage 2 children of Eliot Bank and their Parents and Carers to our Maths evening event on Tuesday 7th March from 6.00pm to approximately 7.30pm in the school hall.

During the event, teams will construct a tower like structure based upon equilateral triangles. The winning entry will be the one which can freely hold a chocolate egg the furthest away from its base. There will be opportunities to use arithmetic skills to purchase and win additional resources using the pot of money given to each team at the start of the event. All resources and equipment required to construct the tower will be provided and teachers will be available to assist if needed. To make it fair, please do not bring any additional resources from home.

Each team can contain a maximum of 4 people but must consist of at least one Eliot Bank child and one known adult. For example, teams might be 3 siblings who attend Eliot Bank and one adult; or 2 children and 2 adults; or child and 2 adults etc. Please note we are happy for known adults to be grandparents, uncles etc., as well as parents and carers. Unfortunately, the event will not be suitable for younger children who do not currently attend Eliot Bank but younger siblings from KS1 are welcome to be part of teams.

This will be a free but ticketed event. If you would like to attend, please complete and return the attached form to your child's class teacher (not to the school office) by Monday 27th February. Each ticket will admit one team into the event and tickets are limited to one per family. Due to the nature of the event there are limited places available so if you are not issued with a ticket you will not be able to attend.

We really hope you will be able to join us for this special event and look forward to seeing you there.

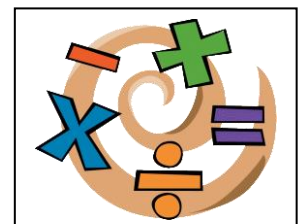
