

Year 2 trip to Horton Kirby

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our geography topic learning this term, we will be visiting Horton Kirby on **Thursday 2nd February**. Based on the traditional story of 'The Town Mouse & The Country Mouse', children will become 'Mice News' reporters for the day. They will be set the task of using their observational and map reading skills to discover the differences between Horton Kirby and Forest Hill. The day will include looking at maps and keys, completing a traffic survey and comparing human and physical features.

We will be travelling by coach and will leave school at approximately 9.30am. The coach is booked to return for a normal collection time of 3.15pm.

The cost of the trip is a voluntary contribution of **£12.50** which will need to be in by **Monday 23rd January**. You can pay this in full or in instalments. If we have difficulty collecting sufficient money for the trip, there is a possibility that we may have to cancel.

It may be cold and wet on the day, and so your child will need to wear **warm** clothing. Please provide them with a **hat** and **gloves**, as well as **wellies** and a **raincoat**. We will be walking through the countryside all day.

All children are entitled to a free school meal and hence will be provided with a packed lunch. However, if you would like to provide a packed lunch for your child, please indicate on the slip below.
