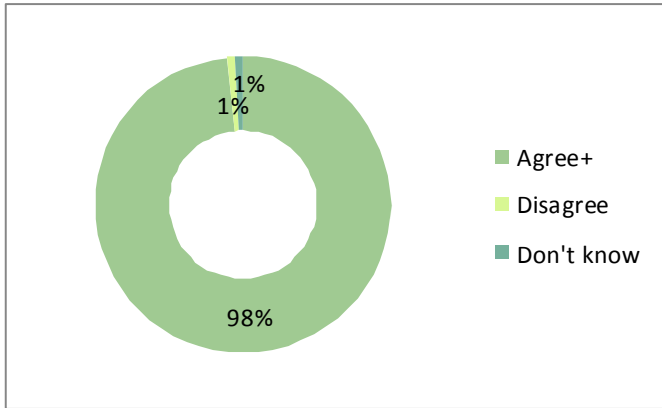




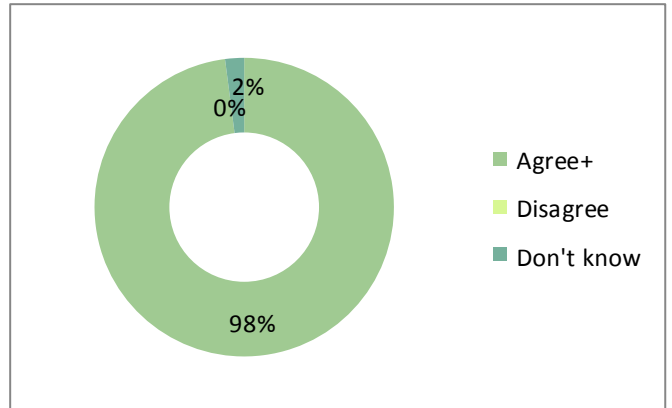
ELIOT BANK PARENT SURVEY OUTCOMES—AUTUMN 2017

We have collated our Autumn Term parent survey results. We were overwhelmed by your positive feedback.

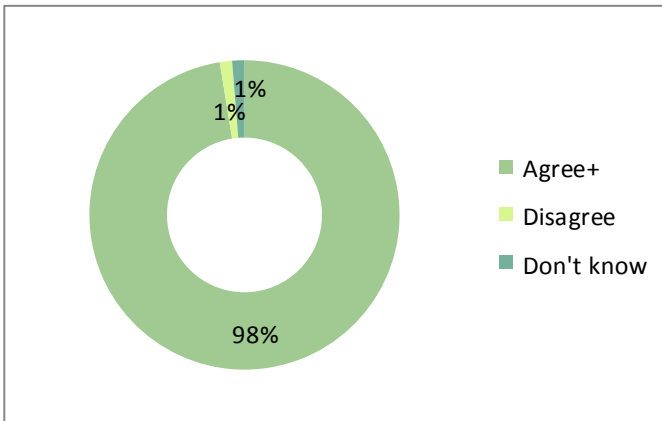
My child is happy at this school



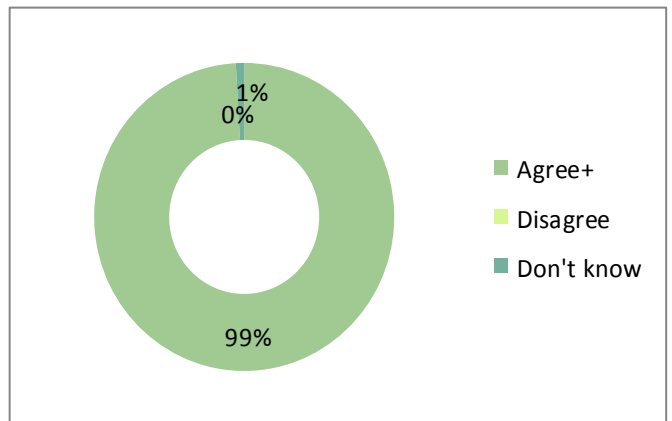
My child feels safe at this school



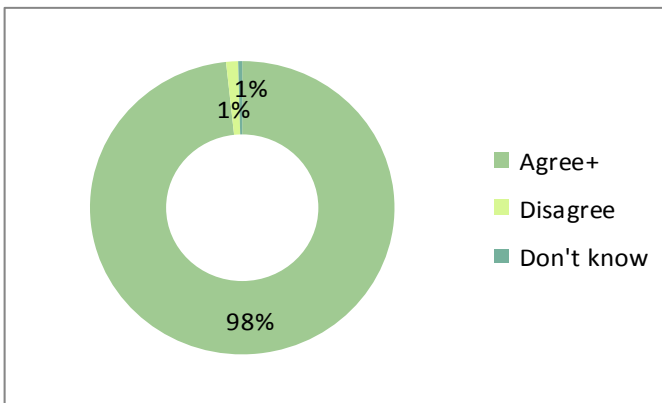
My child makes good progress at this school



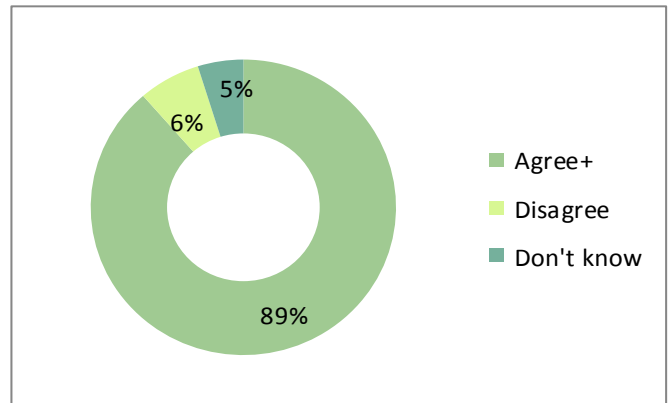
My child is well looked after at this school



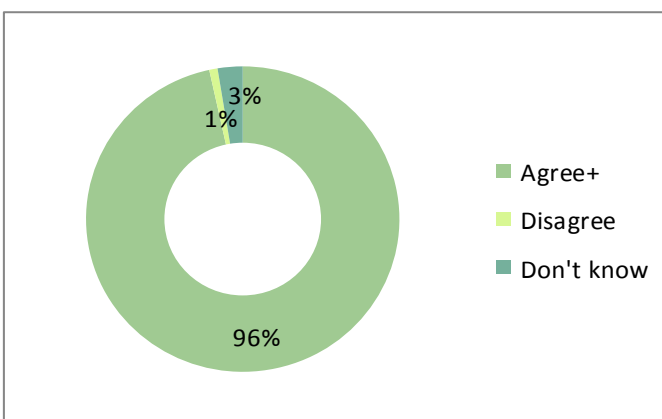
My child is taught well at this school



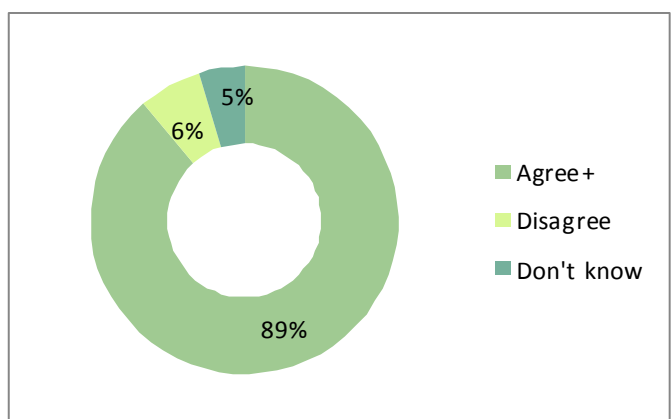
My child receives appropriate homework for their age



This school ensures the pupils are well behaved



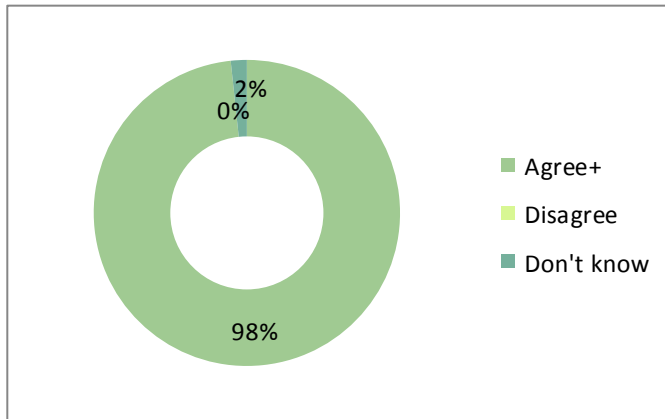

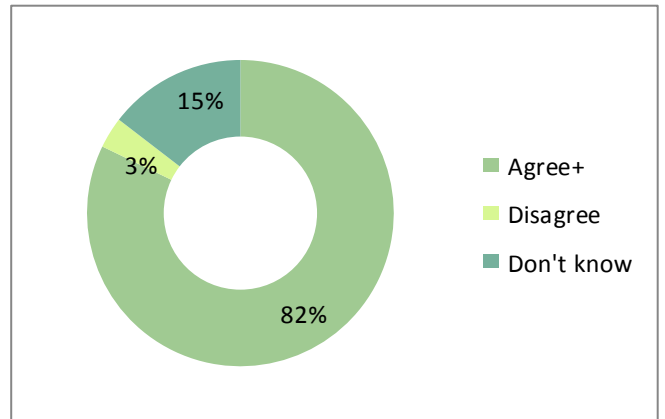

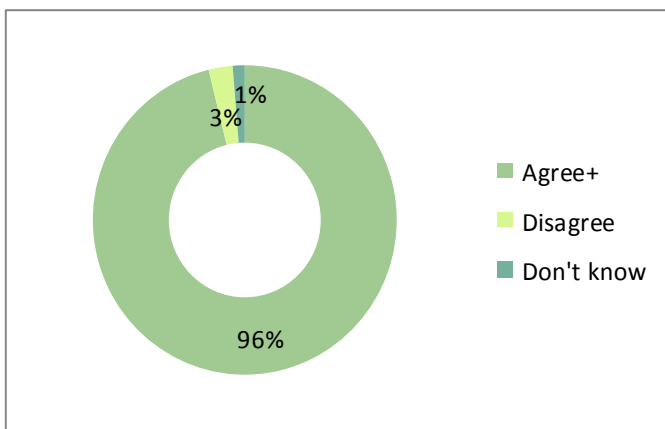
The school is well managed and led



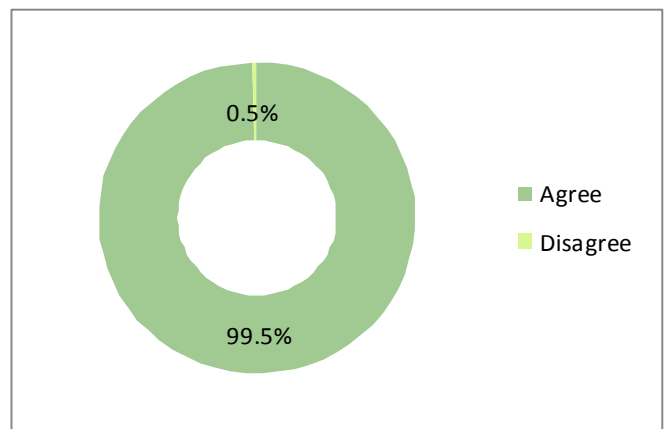
The school responds well to any concerns I raise

In addition to the *strongly agree* and *agree* tick responses, we were inundated with positive comments. We will share these with you in newsletters and on the school website in the New Year.

Feedback from parents is important to us. For some questions, we received 244 responses—this is a fantastic return. Thank you! In areas where *agree* falls below 95%, we have drawn up the following action points:

My child receives appropriate homework for their age

While the majority of parents believe that we provide home learning which is appropriate for their child's age, we note that a number of parents *disagree* or *strongly disagree*. Where comments were included, feedback from those who disagree was mixed. Some parents want more homework; others want less. Some want more online home learning; others want less screen-time and more paper-based homework.

Action: The school will send out an electronic survey to parents in the Spring Term to better understand parents' views on home learning. We will use the outcomes from this to review our home learning provision.

The school deals effectively with bullying

We are reassured that the high percentage of *don't knows* from parents probably reflects the fact that their child hasn't been bullied. Those who agree either recognise our policies are robust or have felt that previous incidents had been dealt with effectively. Incidents of bullying at Eliot Bank are rare, but we have policies in place to respond when they do occur. These policies have been recently updated—please refer to our school website.

Action: The school will create a leaflet for parents which outlines the robust policies and procedures in place to deal with bullying.

The school responds well to any concerns I raise

We believe that the high percentage of *don't knows* is due to the fact that parents have not raised concerns so do not know how well the school responds.
