Design and make your own Anglo Saxon helmet and shield.

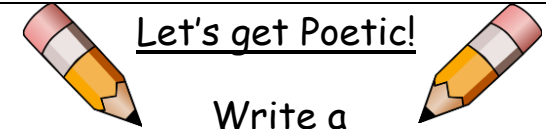


Flag-tastic
