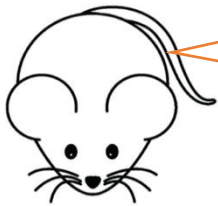


Questioning Koala (who always asks questions) starts with this question today: **Do you think Incy Wincy spider should keep trying to climb up the drain pipe?**

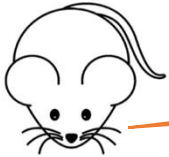
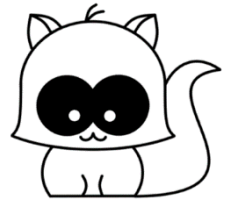
Someone might disagree with my answer because they think...
