from Peter Worley's *The If Machine*

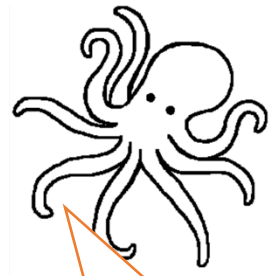
If you haven't already, you will need to complete CB stories 1 (Friends) and 2 (The Test) first.

1 = I know that!

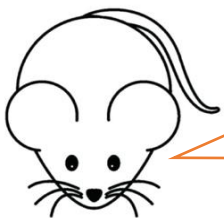
2 = I don't know that, but someone does!

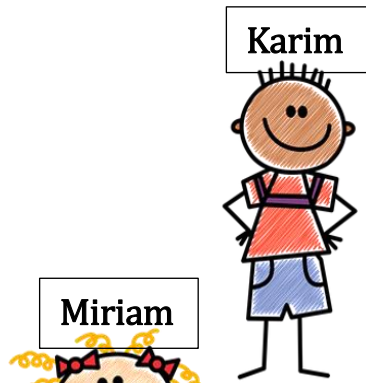

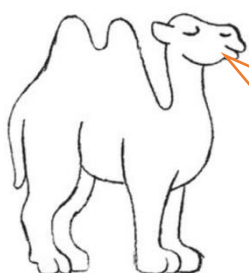
