

Settling into Nursery at Eliot Bank

Young children need to adapt to a new setting, group and class. They need time to adapt to a new environment and people and to the social, emotional, physical and intellectual demands these make on them.

Within the first few weeks of starting Nursery all the children are given the time and space to settle into their environment, allowing them to observe, listen and explore at their own pace. Our children need to feel safe and secure in their new surroundings, both in the nursery and within the whole school.

Have a think about the sort of activities and games you like to play at home.

In Nursery, there will be lots of activities. Some are just like the ones at home and then there will be some new ones such as. . . .

...Sand, Water, Role Play, Construction area, Writing, Painting, Making models, book areas, Playdough, Counting, Learning Letters and Sounds, the Mud Kitchen, Climbing . . .and lots, lots more.

Some children eat their lunch at nursery. We use special yellow trays and we line up at the kitchen counter. Lunch is very yummy!




Eliot Bank Pond . . .
