English

This term, we will be reading 'The Tunnel' by our Author Focus Anthony Browne and a version of Little Red Riding Hood. The children will have the opportunity to explore a variety of texts, share their ideas and present stories using drama and actions. This will then form a basis for their own writing. Later in the term, we will also focus on different types of non-fiction writing, such as instructions.

Maths

This term, will cover a wide range of topics, including place value and addition and subtraction. This will involve lots of practical and written activities, and learning opportunities linked to real life. We will also be focusing on applying these skills to problem solving. Our times table focus will be the 10s, 5s & 2s.

History

This term, we will be learning about The Great Fire of London. Some of the knowledge and skills we will be learning are: identifying differences between the past and present; understanding the impact of an historical event and learning about significant historical figures. We are lucky enough to have a theatre workshop visiting us to further support our History learning.

Science

This term, we will be learning about Materials. This will include exploring different materials and how they bend, twist and stretch. The children will be carrying out experiments to answer scientific questions.

DT

We will be linking our learning to our Great Fire of London topic we will be looking at difference types of bread and then designing our own bread. This will involve the opportunity to taste our creations!

Music

Year 2 will be having weekly sessions with Mr Prescott this term. We will be learning several songs on the glockenspiel and working towards our Grade 1 certificate. We learn about pitch, rhyme and melody.

PE

During outdoor P.E with coach we will be focusing on Aiming, throwing and catching. Our indoor P.E is dance which will be linked to the Great Fire of London, we will be moving our bodies to music to show how the fire spread, making a class routine. Our focus will be to explore the shape, movement and emotions we can show with our bodies.

Art

This term we will be focus on portraits. We will be studying Picasso creating portraits in the style of his work. We will also be mixing paints to create secondary colours. Our sketch books will be used to plan and review our work.

Computing

This term we will look at ICT at school and beyond, in settings such as shops, hospitals, and libraries. We will investigate how information technology improves our world, the children will learn about using information technology responsibly.

RE

We will start the year with learning about Christianity and the teachings of Jesus. After half term, we will learning about the Hindu festival of Diwali, we will be making Diva Lamps and creating Rangoli patterns.

PSHE

In the Autumn term, we will be learning how to stay healthy, we will also be looking at the theme of friendship. Circle Time themes are dependent on the needs of the class but may include discussions around kindness, gratitude and
