Here are some of their beautifully written and ornately decorated chronicles.




We want Children in Need to be a spot-tacular success in 2023, so get involved! At school there will be a special assembly and activities in class.



APPLICATION DEADLINE 15 JANUARY 2024

Children born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020 are eligible to start full-time Reception in September 2024.

Lewisham Council coordinate applications for Reception class places in primary school within the Lewisham Borough. Parents / Carers should apply online directly to their home Local Authority (the borough where they live and pay council tax) via www.eadmissions.org.uk

Applications can be made, via the eadmissions website, until the deadline of Monday 15th January 2024.

Parents are advised to read the information on applying for Primary School Places which can be found at www.lewisham.gov.uk/primaryadmissions. cannot find the information you need, call the Admissions Team on 020 8314 8282 (Monday - Thursday 9am-1pm). You must complete this process to apply for a reception place within a primary school by 15.1.2024.
